To whom it may concern,

In accordance with CVO regulations and new standards, the following information is required by accredited veterinary facilities using third party ultrasound providers:

VetSonix Diagnostic Imaging performs for the following practices for machine maintenance:

- A high-level ultrasound approved disinfectant wipes (Prevail) is used on the probes after every patient/scan.
- A high-level ultrasound approved disinfectant wipe (Prevail) is used routinely on the external casing of the ultrasound machine
- The monitor is cleaned routinely using a lint-free cloth
- The ultrasound machine is assessed daily by Dr. Ibey, and machine repair and servicing is provided by GE healthcare as needed
- Ultrasound images are stored on telemedicine sites (DVMInsight, Antech Imaging Services, IDEXX) and saved to the cloud on a routine basis.
